# **LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES**

✓ **To observe or assist under supervision** in operations deliveries, procedures and to follow ward rounds and dressing, and enable the students' close and in-depth interactions with the doctors, and also interact with nurses, other staffs, patients and local people there.

- ✓ Bedside study for case study, & case presentation for interesting case.
- ✓ Outreach service and or community service or field visit is provided.

## **CHARACTERISTICS**

- 1. Mentor is assigned to each student in ratio of 1: 1 or 1:2 max and students are under the supervision by Mentor, and Mentors may be changed without prior notice.
- 2. Students are allowed to rotate in different departments of hospital for learning practice.
- **3. Guest House** is reserved for students in hospital.
- 4. CMDF Medical Student Sponsorship Scheme is eligible for those successful applicants who are in financial difficulties or burden.
