## **Travel Information**

- Please manage to arrive at Tao Yuan International Airport, Taiwan around **12:30-13:00** on Aug. 4<sup>th</sup> (TUE) or Aug. 7<sup>th</sup> (FRI), 2015. A shuttle bus will be available to drive you to the venue directly.
- If you cannot make it to the above-mentioned time period, please contact TCMA office for further assistance to travel to the venue, the follow information will be helpful to you.

Practical matters when you arrive :

After arriving at Tao Yuan International Airport, you need to go through immigration, collect your baggage and clear customs. You will pass through a set of double doors, Pay attention to two things :

1. First you can exchange local currency in the airport.
  2. Please buy the bus ticket and take the bus right outside the building. Please board the bus (TY bus 桃園客運) to go to the Taiwan High Speed Rail (THSR) Taoyuan Station. The cost is NT\$ 30 and a bus leaves every 20-30m. (Travel time: 20-30mins)
  3. Take the THSR from Taoyuan Station to Taichung Station, The cost is NT\$ 590 and a THSR leaves every 20-30m. (Travel time: 40mins)
  4. Take the Taxi from THSR Taichung Station to *Changhua Christian Hospital* (彰化基督教醫院), The cost is NT\$ 300. (Travel time: 20-30mins)
- Another choice is that you may reserve a car to pick you up in the Tao Yuan International Airport and it will be available to drive you to the venue directly. The cost is NT\$ 4100. (Per car for 2-3 persons) (Travel time: 2 hour)
  - The shuttle bus will be available to drive you from the *Changhua Christian Hospital* to Taoyuan International Airport directly. The bus will be leave at 10:00AM. Aug. 9<sup>th</sup> (SUN), 2015 and will arrive to Taoyuan International Airport around 12:00AM.
