Dr Peter Saunders Chief Executive of the International Christian Medical & Dental Association (ICMDA)

Peter Saunders MA MBChB FRACS was born in New Zealand and originally trained as a General Surgeon, before serving with the Africa Inland Mission at Kapsowar Hospital in Kenya and then completing two years mission training at All Nations Christian College in the UK.

From 1992-2019 he served full-time with Christian Medical Fellowship, a UK-based organisation with 4,500 UK doctors and 1,000 medical students as members, first as Head of Student Ministries and from 1999 as Chief Executive.

In 2019 he started a new role as Chief Executive of the International Christian Medical & Dental Association (ICMDA) which aims to see a Christian witness established through doctors and dentists in every community of every nation.

He was the campaign director for the Care Not Killing Alliance for 13 years and chair of the End of Life Care for Europe group for seven years. He is currently a council member of the Evangelical Alliance.

Peter's wife Kirsty is a community paediatrician and they have three sons Christopher, Benjamin and Jonathan, and two grandchildren. They are members of Spicer Street Church St Albans.

Professor Joseph J Y Sung
Distinguished University Professor
Senior Vice President (Health & Life Sciences)
Dean, Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine
Nanyang Technological University, Singapore



Professor Sung received his medical degree (MBBS) from The University of Hong Kong, and conferred PhD in biomedical sciences by the University of Calgary and MD by The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK). He holds fellowships from the Royal Colleges of Physicians of Edinburgh, Glasgow, London, and Australia, the American College of Gastroenterology, the American Gastroenterological Association, the Hong Kong College of Physicians, the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine and Academy of Sciences of Hong Kong (ASHK). He is an Academician of the Chinese Academy of Engineering of the People's Republic of China and Academician of the International Eurasian Academy of Sciences.

He served as the Vice-Chancellor and President of the Chinese University of Hong Kong from 2010-2017 and the Chair of Worldwide Universities Network (WUN) in 2016-17.

He has published over 1000 full scientific articles in leading medical and scientific journals. He was listed as "Highly Cited Researchers", released by the Clarivate Analytics, for the years 2018, 2019 and 2020. He has edited and authored around 30 books, as well as many chapters in major textbooks including the Oxford Textbook of Medicine (5th Ed.), Sleisenger & Fordtran's Gastrointestinal and Liver Disease (7th &8th Ed) and Yamada's Textbook of Gastroenterology (4th Ed).

Professor Sung is currently Distinguished University Professor, Senior Vice President (Health & Life Sciences) and Dean, Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine at Nanyang Technological University, Singapore. He is also Emeritus Professor in Medicine of CUHK.

Rev. Dr. Patrick Fung is currently the General Director of OMF International, formerly the China Inland Mission. Dr Fung was born in HK. He was trained as a physician in Australia with subsequent specialist training in the UK. He was also a graduate from Fuller Theological Seminary in missiology. He and his wife previously served as medical missionaries in South Asia. Patrick is actively involved in missionary training and preaching ministry. Patrick was the Bible expositor for Urbana US in 2015, plenary speaker for the Cape Town 2010 Third Lausanne Congress on World Evangelization, one of the Keswick Bible conference speakers in the UK in 2011 & 2015 and also the speaker for the Hong Kong Bible conference in 2016.

Dr. Choi received his medical degree (MBBS) from the University of Hong Kong. After two years of physician training in United Christian Hospital, Dr. Choi was motivated to enrolled into anatomical pathology training. He joined the Department of Pathology Queen Mary Hospital University of Hong Kong and subsequently conferred the fellowships of Royal College of Pathologist of United Kingdom, the Hong Kong College of Pathologists, and the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine (Pathology). He returned to United Christian Hospital a few years after becoming a specialist in pathology, serving as Senior Medical Officer and then Consultant Pathologist and Chief of Service in the Department of Pathology. During the SARS epidemic, he served also as the Deputy Hospital Chief Executive of the hospital, assisting the chief executive in fighting the threats the hospital faced during the epidemic.

Following the calling of God, Dr. Choi early retired from his 25 years long medical profession, received his Master of Christian Study (MCS) from China Graduate School of Theology in Hong Kong and joined the pastoral team of his mother church serving mainly young adults and families. During this time, he also received the Master of Christian Marriage and Family Therapy (MCMFT) from the Bethel Bible Seminary and certified facilitator of Prepare/Enrich couple assessment program.

Dr. Choi has retired from full time pastoral ministry in January 2021. He still served as a member of the Public Complaint Committee of Hospital Authority in Hong Kong, and a Doctor of Ministry candidate at Evangel Seminary Hong Kong.

Mr. Chan had been a teacher in United Christian College for nine years after graduating in Canada and had also completed a part-time study with distinction in the Faculty of Education of the Chinese University of Hong Kong. He then joined Christian Zheng Sheng Association Ltd. In 1995 as he witnessed marginal youth with potentials wasting their lives because of lack of recognition by the society. Christian Zheng Sheng College, the first and only one dedicated for young drug abusers in Asia, was thus established. There, students are loved and cared with realistic expectations. The innovative curriculum consists of academic subjects and vocational training in their self-support business operations such as pizza house, Chinese Teaism, iron-on transfer service centre, AV production, laser engraving service. His empowerment comes from the love of Jesus. He wants to see more schools serving marginal youths in Hong Kong in the coming decade.
